WHAT IS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Household hazardous wastes (HHW) are products that contain ingredients that are toxic, flammable, corrosive or reactive.

These include pool chemicals, paint thinner, pesticides, fluorescent lamps, car batteries and other items listed on this flyer.

HHW BEST PRACTICES

- ✓ **REDUCE** waste by purchasing only the amount needed to do the job.
- ✓ **REUSE** products by donating unused portions of common items to friends, family or community organizations.
- ✓ **RECYCLE** by taking unwanted or expired products to the Household Hazardous Waste Collections.

HANDLING HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Do not mix chemicals together.
- Do not smoke around chemicals.
- Keep chemicals in original containers with label intact, if possible. If product is missing original label, mark it yourself if you are sure of the contents.
- If a chemical leaks, secure it in a secondary leak-proof container or clear plastic bag.
- Package chemicals securely in non-leaking containers or boxes. Do not combine all of your chemicals in a trash bag. This could cause a fire or chemical reaction.
- During transport, place the container in a well ventilated space away from the driver and passengers, such as a trunk or bed of vehicle.

WHAT CAN BE COLLECTED AT THE CURB

Products containing hazardous ingredients and are labeled with words such as poison, danger, toxic, flammable, corrosive and reactive. The items shown below are examples of accepted materials.

1. Household Products

- Adhesives
- Drain openers
- Aerosols
- Pest control
- Cleaners
- Solvents

2. Paint Products & Stains

Minimum 1 gal., Maximum 4 gals

- Paint
- Stain
- Solvents

4. Yard Products

- Fertilizers
- Pesticides
- Herbicides
- Poisons

5. Auto Products

Minimum 1 gal., Maximum 8 gal.

- Antifreeze
- Motor oil
- Diesel
- Waxes, cleaners and polishes
- Gasoline

6. Personal Care Products

- Nail polish remover
- Peroxides
- Rubbing

8. Pool & Spa Products

Minimum 1 gal., Maximum 4 gals.

- Pool/Spa chemicals and cleaners

9. Batteries Auto/Marine

Minimum 1, Maximum 20

- Lead-acid
 - Rechargeable (Ni-Cd, Li-Ion, Ni-MH, Lithium)
- NOTE: Single-use alkaline batteries (AA, C, D) may be discarded in the regular trash.

3. Mercury Lamps & Devices

Minimum 1, Maximum 8

- Compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs)
- Fluorescent lamps
- Mercury thermometers
- Mercury thermostats

7. Ammunition, Fireworks & Flares

10. Propane/Helium Tanks

- Propane Tanks 30 lb. or less Limit 2
- Helium Tanks 20 lb. or less
- Fire Extinguishers
